The Veterinary Teaching Hospital and the Dentistry and Oral Surgery Service at Colorado State University are offering a one-year postdoctoral fellowship in dentistry and oral surgery. The position is designed for veterinarians who have completed a 3-year AVDC approved residency (or equivalent) in dentistry and oral surgery. The DOSS fellowship position will have clinical and teaching responsibilities within the Dentistry and Oral Surgery Service.

The 12-month appointment will consist of 10 months of clinical duties and research related to dentistry and oral surgery with 8 additional off-clinic weeks. The appointment is for one year. The proposed starting date is November 15, 2011.
