

Professional Veterinary Medicine (PVM) Scholarships

All of the Scholarships listed here are *college-based* (College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences) **and are applied for by** Professional Veterinary Medicine (PVM) students, enrolled in their first, second, or third year of the PVM program, by **participating in the on-line PVM Scholarship Application process**. The application process takes place in November of each year for the selection of recipients of scholarships to be awarded for the next academic year. (Certain of these scholarships may require an additional application process that is explained to eligible students at the time of the general PVM application process.) Students who choose to submit PVM scholarship applications make up the applicant pool from which scholarship recipients are selected. There may be additions or deletions to this list before the actual distribution of scholarships takes place. ***Yearly distribution is dependent on availability of funding.***

When the college receives notification of a scholarship administered by an organization outside of our college for which PVM students may be eligible, the scholarship is announced through e-mail to eligible students so that interested individuals may apply. The Colorado State University Student Financial Services Office is also a resource for students searching for scholarship opportunities.
