

2008-2009 Institutional Scholarships

Target Populations:

1. Top 20% of Non-resident students
2. Top 10% of Resident students
3. Low-income, first generation, and/or diverse Colorado residents
4. Community college transfer students

To be considered for freshman scholarships, students must apply for Admission by February 1 and be admitted by March 1. To be considered for transfer scholarships, students must be admitted by June 1.

Scholarship	Amount	Who?
Alliance Award	\$2000/year* 4 Years	Colorado resident freshmen who graduate from Alliance high schools.
Green and Gold Scholarship	\$2000/year 4 Years	Competitive selection of Colorado resident freshmen based on rigor of HS coursework, GPA, test scores, extracurricular activities, etc.
Honors Scholarship	Resident: \$1000 Non-resident: \$2000 4 Years	Freshmen who are admitted and participate in the Honors program.
National Merit CSU Scholarship	\$500-\$2000 depending on need 4 Years	Freshmen National Merit Finalists who list CSU as their 1 st choice school with National Merit.
Partnership Award	Resident: \$2500* Non-resident: \$5000* 4 Years	Competitive selection of freshmen based on rigor of HS coursework, GPA, test scores, extracurricular activities, etc. Student must have participated in a Partnership program.
Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship	Resident: \$2000 Non-resident: \$6000 2 Years	Competitive selection of incoming transfer students based on rigor of transfer coursework, GPA, extracurricular activities, etc. Must be a member of Phi Theta Kappa.
President's Public Service Award	\$1000 one-time award	Entering freshmen who have significant public service engagement in community and/or nonprofit agency.
Presidential Scholarship	Non-resident: \$6000 4 Years (WUE students not elig)	Competitive selection of non-resident freshmen based on rigor of HS coursework, GPA, test scores, extracurricular activities, etc.
Provost's Scholarship	Non-resident: \$4000 4 Years (WUE students not elig)	Competitive selection of non-resident freshmen based on rigor of HS coursework, GPA, test scores, extracurricular activities, etc.
Ram Transfer Scholarship	Resident: \$1000 Non-resident: \$5000 2 Years	Competitive selection of incoming transfer students based on rigor of transfer coursework, GPA, extracurricular activities, etc.
STARS Scholarship	\$2000 4 Years	Colorado resident freshman who graduated from a STARS high school. Competitive selection based on rigor of HS coursework, GPA, test scores, extracurricular activities, etc.

* Award can be increased up to tuition and fees if the student shows need.

Policy Notes:

- The STARS, Alliance, Partnership, or First Generation are not stackable. Partnership trumps all.
- The Presidential and Provost's are not stackable.
- WUE is not stackable with Provost's or Presidential
- The Phi Theta Kappa and Ram Transfer are not stackable
- National Merit Recipients, National Hispanic Scholars, Boettcher Scholars, and National Achievement Scholars are automatically awarded the Green and Gold or Presidential (depending on residency).
