Calving Management Training	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initial visit</li> <li>• 4-hour training on dairy or at CSU with classroom and hands-on sessions</li> <li>• Follow-up visit</li> </ul>	\$750.00
Physical Exam, Disease Diagnosis and Treatment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Initial visit</li> <li>• 4-hour training on dairy with classroom and hands-on sessions</li> <li>• Follow-up visit</li> </ul>	\$750.00

Initial visit:           Take photos of farm to include in training  
                               Discuss problem areas and topics to be emphasized during training  
                               Cursory evaluation of herd records system, discussion of monitoring tools options

Follow-up visit:       Interview area managers/workers regarding usefulness of training  
                               Discussion session to address new questions and concerns  
                               Evaluation of intervention impact through established monitoring tools
