

The Professional Veterinary Medical (PVM) Program in the College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences at Colorado State University is fully accredited by the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) Council on Education. The PVM Program was last accredited in 2008 for 7 years, the maximum amount of time granted by the AVMA. The next accreditation site visit will be in 2015.

Students in the PVM Class of 2010 had a pass rate on the North American Veterinary Licensing Exam (NAVLE) of 95% (125 out of 131) following the November-December 2009 exam and a total pass rate of 98% (130 out of 132) following the April 2010 exam.

In the PVM Class of 2011, 131 students took the NAVLE in November-December, 2010, with 125 passing the exam giving an initial pass rate of 95%. The results from the April exam will be available in the summer.

The AVMA Council on Education requires an 80% pass rate on NAVLE to maintain accreditation.
